Report on the audit of the Standalone Financial Results Opinion

We have audited the accompanying standalone financial results of CONSECUTIVE INVESTMENTS & TRADING COMPANY LIMITED (the company) for the quarter and year ended 31st March, 2025 ("the statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "LODR Regulations").

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, these standalone financial results:

- (a) are presented in accordance with the requirements of Regulation 33 of the LODR Regulations in this regard; and
- (b) give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable accounting standards and other accounting principles generally accepted in India of the standalone net profit/(loss), other comprehensive income/(expenses) and other financial information of the company for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2025.

Basis of Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013. Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Standalone Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India ("ICAI") together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements under the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the ICAI's Code of Ethics.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Emphasis of Matters

We draw attention to the balances of trade receivables, Inventories and trade payables as at the balance sheet date, which are subject to certain uncertainties. Our audit procedures were unable to fully verify the accuracy and recoverability/payability of these balances. Accordingly, the final realizable value of trade receivables, inventories and the settlement amount of trade payables may differ from the amounts stated in the financial statements. Further, Inventories are not verified by us as the same has been taken on the basis of management representation and verified by the management of the

company & we are relied on the management report. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibilities of Management and Board of Directors for the Standalone Financial Results

These standalone financial results have been prepared on the basis of the interim financial statements. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the standalone financial results that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the standalone financial results, the Board of Directors are responsible for assessing the Company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Board of Directors are also responsible for overseeing the Company's financial reporting process.

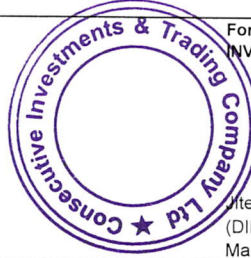

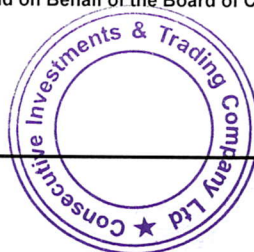

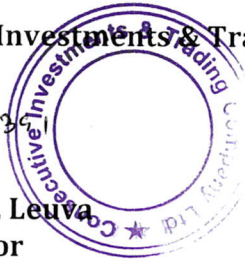
